

Definition:

An island exhibit space is 400 square feet or larger with aisles on all four sides.

Use of Space:

An island booth exhibit space is separated by the width of an aisle from all neighboring exhibits so full use of the exhibit space is permitted.

Height: **Note the ceiling height in the expo hall is only 18ft. Please contact Danny Rosenstock at 630.271.3009 to discuss the type of sign you would like to hang so we can get approval from the Hilton Anatole.**

All display fixtures, components including graphics and identification signs are allowed a maximum height of **TBD**. Some venues have low ceiling areas so please check the exhibitor resource kit for any notices for exhibit spaces in a low ceiling location.

Multi-level or Ceilings:

Exhibitors installing a display with a ceiling or second level must meet all building, fire safety and structural integrity regulations.

All exhibit spaces must adhere to display regulations:

Including ADA, demonstrations, lighting, sound, structural integrity, and storage.
